The project involves upgrading the two existing crosswalks on Route 8, adding two new crosswalks on Route 221, and installing two sets of flashing beacons at the existing crosswalks to alert drivers to pedestrians.

The hearing will be held in an "open-house" format and VDOT representatives will be present to answer questions.
