

Floyd County, Virginia is accepting applications for Flex-time ALS or BLS provider positions with Floyd County Emergency Medical Services.

Responsibilities include responding to 911 calls, providing pre-hospital basic and/or advanced life support care and transporting those patients to regional hospitals.

Applicants for ALS should have a minimum of one year's experience at the Intermediate or Paramedic level. Applicants for BLS should have a minimum of one year's experience. Candidates must be at least 21 years of age, possess a valid Virginia driver's license, and hold a current Class 2 EVOC certification or higher. Candidates with current ACLS, PHTLS, AMLS, GEMS, PALS or PEPP certifications are preferred. A knowledge of Floyd County roads and highways, and familiarity with current Western Virginia Operational Protocols is preferred.

Interested candidates may submit a Commonwealth of Virginia employment application, along with copies of their current EMS certifications. A Department of Motor Vehicles record must be supplied by the applicant on the day of his or her interview. Successful applicants will be required to undergo a VSP/FBI criminal history background check.
