March 3rd from 6am until 7 pm

Vote at the Registrar's Office before Election Day if you qualify for an absentee ballot
Available until 5 pm February 29th

Vote by mail before Election Day if you qualify for an absentee ballot
Apply by 5 pm on February 25th

In addition to regular office hours,
The Registrar's Office will open
Saturday, February 29, 2020 from 9 am to 5 pm
for absentee voting in-person

The Constitution of Virginia requires that you be registered in the precinct in which you live in order to be qualified to vote. Any qualified resident of the Commonwealth of Virginia may make application for voter registration at the above places and times. Persons already registered who need to change their resident address may do so by completing a voter registration application. All requests for reasonable accommodations due to a disability should be made to the Registrar at the telephone number listed above with at least 48 hour notice.

Bring your photo ID
You need to show your photo ID whenever you vote in person
If you do not have an acceptable form of identification please
contact the Floyd County Voter Registration Office for a free photo ID
